SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Grants authority to Department of Revenue to examine premises of person or place of business licensed under tobacco tax chapter.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to examination by Department of Revenue of tobacco tax licensee premises.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2009 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 323.**

5 **SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, "premises" or "licensed premises":**

6 **(a) Means a place of business licensed under this chapter or a place of business used for**
7 **the sale or distribution of cigarettes or tobacco products by a person licensed under this**
8 **chapter.**

9 **(b) Includes all enclosed areas at the location that are used in the business operated at**
10 **the location, including offices, kitchens, rest rooms and storerooms, including all public and**
11 **private areas where patrons are permitted to be present.**

12 **(2) The Department of Revenue may at any time make an examination of the premises**
13 **of any person or place of business licensed under this chapter. The department may, after**
14 **72 hours' notice to the owner or the agent of the owner of the premises, make an examina-**
15 **tion of records required to be maintained under ORS 323.220 or 323.540.**
