Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by Department of State Lands to pay costs of Oregon territorial sea mapping project.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2009.

2	Relating to Oregon territorial sea mapping project; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emer-

4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
6	\$1,289,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for
7	payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,
8	but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of
9	State Lands, to pay the costs of the Oregon territorial sea mapping project at Oregon State
10	University.
11	SECTION 2. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
12	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect
13	on July 1, 2009.
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
