SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Human Services to review statutory laws governing programs administered by department and identify changes needed to reflect budget changes. Directs department to report changes to Legislative Assembly.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to Department of Human Services program changes caused by budget reductions; and de-3 claring an emergency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Department of Human Services shall review the statutory laws govern-

6 ing programs administered by the department and shall determine needed changes to those

7 laws to reflect budget changes. The department shall report its findings to the Legislative

8 Assembly.

9 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 10 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect 11 on its passage.

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
