#### **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Increases civil aircraft registration and renewal fees. Adds registration and renewal fee for single engine turboprop.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2009.

### 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to aviation; amending ORS 837.045; and declaring an emergency.

#### Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 837.045 is amended to read:

837.045. (1) The registration fee to be paid under ORS 837.040, and the fee to be paid upon renewal of registration under ORS 837.060, is as follows:
