SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Allows certain members of Oregon National Guard to administer health care services in emergency.]

Allows Governor to authorize certain members of Oregon National Guard to provide health care services when Governor declares certain emergencies.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to Oregon National Guard.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. When the Governor declares a state of emergency under ORS 401.055 or a**
5 **public health emergency under ORS 433.441, the Governor, as part of the declaration of**
6 **emergency, may authorize members of the Oregon National Guard on active state duty or**
7 **Title 32 orders to provide health care services in Oregon without being subject to the Oregon**
8 **licensing requirements for health care providers, provided that each member is qualified by**
9 **virtue of the member's military duty position, training and qualifications to perform the**
10 **same or similar functions as an Oregon licensed health care provider for the Armed Forces**
11 **of the United States under either state or federal status.**
