## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows certain members of Oregon National Guard to administer health care services in emergency.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to Oregon National Guard; amending ORS 401.651.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 401.651 is amended to read:

5 401.651. As used in ORS 401.651 to 401.670:

6 (1) "Health care facility" means a health care facility as defined in ORS 442.015 that has been  
7 licensed under ORS chapter 441.

8 (2) "Health care provider" means:

9 (a) An individual licensed, certified or otherwise authorized or permitted by the laws of this  
10 state to administer health care services in the ordinary course of business or practice of a profes-  
11 sion.

12 (b) **A member of the Oregon National Guard who is trained and certified by the Armed**  
13 **Forces of the United States or a reserve component to administer health care services in**  
14 **an emergency.**
