SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Changes name of Criminal History Registry to Central Background Registry.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to Central Background Registry; amending ORS 657A.030 and 657A.275.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 657A.030 is amended to read: 4

657A.030. (1) The Child Care Division of the Employment Department shall establish a [Criminal 5

6 History] Central Background Registry.

7 (2) All subject individuals shall be enrolled in the [Criminal History] Central Background 8 Registry established by the division.

- 9 (3) Upon receiving an application for enrollment in the [Criminal History] Central Background
- Registry, the division shall complete a criminal records check under ORS 181.534 and shall complete 10

a child protective services records check with the Department of Human Services. The division shall 11

12 enroll the individual in the registry if the individual:

(a) Is determined to have no criminal or child protective services history or to have dealt with 13the issues and provided adequate evidence of suitability for the registry; 14

(b) Has paid the applicable fee established pursuant to ORS 657A.275; and 15

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(c) Has complied with the rules of the division adopted pursuant to this section.

17 (4) The division may conditionally enroll an individual in the registry pending the results of a nationwide criminal records check through the Federal Bureau of Investigation if the individual has 18 19 met other requirements of the division for enrollment in the registry.

20 (5) An enrollment in the [Criminal History] Central Background Registry shall expire two years 21from the date of enrollment and may be renewed upon application to the division, payment of the 22fee established pursuant to ORS 657A.275 and compliance with rules adopted by the division pursuant to this section. However, an individual who is determined to be ineligible for enrollment in the 2324 registry after the date of initial enrollment shall be removed from the registry by the division.

25(6)(a) A child care facility shall not hire or employ an individual if the individual is not enrolled 26 in the [Criminal History] Central Background Registry.

27(b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a) of this subsection, a child care facility may employ on a 28 probationary basis an individual who is conditionally enrolled in the [Criminal History] Central 29 Background Registry.

30 (7) The division may adopt any rules necessary to carry out the purposes of this section and the criminal records check program. 31

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(8) For purposes of this section, "subject individual" means a subject individual as defined by 1 2 the division by rule or a person who applies to be: (a) The operator or an employee of a child care or treatment program; 3 (b) The operator or an employee of an Oregon prekindergarten program under ORS 329.170 to 4 329.200; 5 (c) The operator or an employee of a federal Head Start program regulated by the United States 6 Department of Health and Human Services; 7 (d) An individual in a child care facility who may have unsupervised contact with children as 8 9 identified by the division; (e) A contractor or an employee of the contractor who provides early childhood special educa-10 tion or early intervention services pursuant to ORS 343.455 to 343.534; or 11 12 (f) A child care provider who is required to be enrolled in the [Criminal History] Central 13 **Background** Registry by any state agency. SECTION 2. ORS 657A.275 is amended to read: 14 15 657A.275. (1) Subject to prior approval of the Oregon Department of Administrative Services and a report to the Legislative Assembly prior to adopting the fees and charges, the fees and charges 16 established under ORS 181.534, 657A.030 and 657A.250 to 657A.450 may not exceed the cost of ad-17 ministering the program of the Child Care Division of the Employment Department pertaining to the 18 purpose for which the fee is established, as authorized by the Legislative Assembly within the 19 budget of the division. 20(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section and any other provision of this chapter, the 2122following fees established by the division under ORS 657A.030 and 657A.250 to 657A.450 may not 23exceed: (a) For Certified Family Child Care Home Initial Certification, \$25; 24(b) For Certified Family Child Care Home Annual Fee Per Certified Space, \$2; 25(c) For Child Care Center Initial Certification, \$100; 26(d) For Child Care Center Annual Fee Per Certified Space, \$2; 27(e) For Registered Family Child Care Home Registration, \$30; 28(f) For administering a class on child care abuse and neglect issues, \$10; and 2930 (g) For enrollment in the [Criminal History] Central Background Registry, the cost of admin-31 istering the program, including fees for: (A) Duplicate enrollment in the [Criminal History] Central Background Registry; 32(B) Law Enforcement Data System criminal records check; and 33 34 (C) Federal Bureau of Investigation fingerprint check.

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
