

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2212

By COMMITTEE ON AGRICULTURE, NATURAL RESOURCES AND RURAL
COMMUNITIES

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, line 6, delete “weed” and insert “a noxious weed as defined in
2 ORS 452.610”.

3 In line 17, delete “The department believes that”.

4 In line 21, after “or” insert “knowingly”.

5 On page 3, delete lines 5 through 14 and insert “570.180. This subsection does not apply to
6 compensation for an abatement-related loss that results from the application of a pesticide in a
7 faulty, careless or negligent manner.”.

8 On page 4, delete lines 34 through 36 and insert:

9 “(2) Implement an integrated weed management approach that focuses on the prevention of
10 noxious weeds through:

11 “(a) A combination of techniques that may include, but need not be limited to, the use of:

12 “(A) Surveillance and monitoring;

13 “(B) Early detection;

14 “(C) Eradication or other rapid response techniques;

15 “(D) Mechanical control;

16 “(E) The selective use of pesticides;

17 “(F) Cultural practices;

18 “(G) Modified land management; and

19 “(H) Biological controls; and

20 “(b) Control practices selected and applied to achieve desired weed management objectives in
21 a manner that minimizes risks to human health, non-target organisms, native fish and wildlife
22 habitat, watersheds and the environment.”.

23 On page 5, after line 22, insert:

24 “(14) If abatement procedures are required of a landowner, recommend that the landowner and
25 the department jointly develop a management strategy or plan that describes a course of action to
26 address the abatement requirement.”.

27 In line 23, delete “(14)” and insert “(15)”.

28 In line 28, delete “(15)” and insert “(16)”.

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
