

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2219

By COMMITTEE ON AGRICULTURE, NATURAL RESOURCES AND RURAL
COMMUNITIES

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “creating new provisions; and”.

2 Delete lines 5 through 31 and delete page 2 and insert:

3 “**SECTION 1.** Section 2, chapter 460, Oregon Laws 1995, as amended by section 1, chapter 227,
4 Oregon Laws 2001, is amended to read:

5 “**Sec. 2.** Notwithstanding any other provision of the wildlife laws, during the period beginning
6 January 1, 1996, and ending January 2, [2010,] **2014**, the following provisions apply with regard to
7 the issuance and use of landowner preference tags referred to in ORS 496.146 (4):

8 “(1) Landowner preference tags shall be issued for the hunting of deer, elk or antelope.

9 “(2) Landowner preference tags may be used only for hunting on the landowner’s property.

10 “(3) Landowner preference tags for the hunting of deer or elk may be transferred to any person
11 of the landowner’s choosing and shall be used for the taking of antlerless animals except as au-
12 thorized by subsection (6) of this section.

13 “(4) Landowner preference tags for the hunting of antelope are not transferable and may not
14 be used for the taking of buck antelope.

15 “(5) Each landowner preference tag for the hunting of deer or elk may be used to take two
16 antlerless animals before, during or after the hunting season for which the tags are valid for the
17 purpose of alleviating damage that is presently occurring to the landowner’s property, in accordance
18 with such rules as the State Fish and Wildlife Commission may adopt.

19 “(6) Landowner preference tags for the hunting of deer or elk that are transferred to a person
20 of the landowner’s choosing who is not a member of the landowner’s immediate family may be used
21 to take an antlered animal only as follows:

22 “(a) If the landowner receives one preference tag, that tag may not be so used.

23 “(b) If the landowner receives two, three or four preference tags, one of those tags may be so
24 used.

25 “(c) If the landowner receives five, six or seven preference tags, two of those tags may be so
26 used.

27 “(d) If the landowner receives eight, nine or 10 preference tags, three of those tags may be so
28 used.”.
