SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits reduction of additional compensation payable by county to district attorney during district attorney's term of office.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to district attorneys; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 8.830.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 8.830 is amended to read:

5 8.830. (1) Whenever, in the judgment of any county court or board of county commissioners, the
6 salaries paid by the state to the district attorney, or to any deputy district attorney, are not
7 commensurate with the character of the service performed, the county court or board of county
8 commissioners may pay out of the funds of the county such additional amounts as will properly
9 compensate said officers for the service performed.

10 **(2) If the county court or board of county commissioners elect to pay additional com-**
11 **pen- sation to a district attorney under this section, the additional compensation may not be**
12 **reduced during the district attorney's term of office.**

13 **SECTION 2.** (1) **Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, the amendments to**
14 **ORS 8.830 by section 1 of this 2009 Act apply to all district attorneys, without regard to**
15 **whether their terms commence before, on or after the effective date of this 2009 Act.**

16 **(2) The amendments to ORS 8.830 by section 1 of this 2009 Act do not apply to any re-**
17 **duction in the compensation of a district attorney that occurred before the effective date of**
18 **this 2009 Act.**
