## House Bill 2385

Sponsored by Representative RILEY; Representatives HOLVEY, KOMP, Senator BURDICK (Presession filed.)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Creates offense of smoking in motor vehicle while person under age of 17 is in motor vehicle. Punishes by maximum fine of \$90 for first offense, \$180 for second offense and \$360 for third or subsequent offense.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to smoking in a motor vehicle. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2009 Act is added to and made a part of the Oregon Vehicle Code. 5 SECTION 2. (1) A person commits the offense of smoking in a motor vehicle if the person 6 7 smokes cigars, cigarettes or tobacco in any form in a motor vehicle while a person under 17 years of age is in the motor vehicle. 8 (2) The offense described in this section, smoking in a motor vehicle, is a: 9 10 (a) Class D traffic violation for a first offense. (b) Class C traffic violation for a second offense. 11 (c) Class B traffic violation for a third or subsequent offense. 12
