

House Bill 2400

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY (at the request of Oregon Council of Police Associations)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs county sheriff's departments and municipal police departments to adopt policy addressing whether members may appear in uniform while off-duty.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to certain peace officers.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Each county sheriff's department and municipal police department shall**
5 **adopt a policy that addresses whether a member of that department may publicly appear in**
6 **uniform while off-duty. All members of each department must be subject to that depart-**
7 **ment's policy.**
