## House Bill 2415

Sponsored by Representative MAURER

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Requires Board on Public Safety Standards and Training to determine length of grace period within which investigator may renew license. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 703.445 is amended to read:

6 703.445. (1) An investigator who desires to continue to practice in this state must apply for re-7 newal and:

8 (a) Pay [the] a renewal fee [as prescribed by rule of the Board on Public Safety Standards and 9 Training] to the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training on or before the renewal date 10 of the license;[.] or

(b) [Any person who fails to pay the renewal fee by the renewal date may, within the following 30 days,] Pay the renewal fee plus a penalty to the department before the expiration of the grace period adopted under subsection (5) of this section [in an amount to be prescribed by board rule, not to exceed twice the amount of the renewal fee].

(2) Any person who fails to [pay the renewal fee, with accrued penalties, for a period of 30 days after the renewal date] renew an investigator's license before the expiration of the grace period forfeits the right to work as an investigator in this state and may be reinstated only upon compliance with the initial application procedures.

19 [(2)] (3) Prior to renewing a license, the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training 20 may request that the Department of State Police conduct criminal records checks as provided in 21 ORS 181.534. Any act that is grounds for denying an initial application for a license is grounds for 22 refusing to renew a license.

[(3)] (4) An investigator may request the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training to place the investigator on inactive status at any time during the licensing period. Upon payment of the inactive license fee as prescribed by rule of the board, the department shall place the investigator on inactive status. An investigator on inactive status may not work as an investigator.

(5) The Board on Public Safety Standards and Training shall adopt rules prescribing:

(a) The amount of the renewal fee and the penalty that are described in subsection (1)
of this section. The penalty may not exceed twice the amount of the renewal fee.

(b) The length of a grace period within which an investigator who fails to pay the renewal
 fee to the department on or before the renewal date of the license may renew a license

1 without complying with the initial application procedures.

2 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) The amendments to ORS 703.445 by section 1 of this 2009 Act become 3 operative on, and apply to license renewal dates occurring on or after, January 1, 2010.

4 (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, the Board on Public Safety Standards 5 and Training may adopt rules or take any other action before the operative date specified in 6 subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the board to exercise, on or after 7 the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all the duties, functions and 8 powers conferred on the board by the amendments to ORS 703.445 by section 1 of this 2009 9 Act.

10 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 11 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect 12 on its passage.
