

House Bill 2458

Sponsored by Representative BERGER (at the request of Oregon Potato Commission)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows commodity commission to establish per diem payment to members that exceeds payment amount otherwise allowed.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to commodity commissions; amending ORS 576.265.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 576.265 is amended to read:

5 576.265. (1) **A commodity commission may adopt rules establishing the amount of pay-**
6 **ment that a member of the commission receives under ORS 292.495 (1) for each day or por-**
7 **tion of a day during which the member is actually engaged in the performance of official**
8 **duties. The amount may exceed, but not be less than, the amount of payment that would**
9 **otherwise be provided under ORS 292.495 (1).**

10 (2) Members, officers and employees of a commodity commission shall receive their actual and
11 necessary travel and other expenses incurred in the performance of their official duties. **Subject to**
12 **any limitations described under ORS 292.495 (2),** the commission shall adopt uniform and rea-
13 sonable [*regulations*] **rules** governing the incurring and paying of such expenses.
