(1) As used in this section, 'reciprocal license' means a license or permit 21issued in another state by a state or local law enforcement agency, a court or another issu-22ing authority that authorizes the licensee or permittee to carry a concealed handgun in the state in which the license or permit was issued, if the other state: 2324 (a) Authorizes a person who is licensed under ORS 166.291 and 166.292 to carry a con-25cealed handgun in the other state; and 26"(b) Imposes eligibility requirements for the issuance of the license or permit that are 27substantially similar to the requirements of ORS 166.291 and 166.292. 28"(2) The Department of State Police shall adopt rules that identify states that issue re-29ciprocal licenses. "SECTION 7. (1) Section 6 of this 2009 Act and the amendments to ORS 166.173, 166.260, 30 31 166.262, 166.370 and 166.663 by sections 1 to 5 of this 2009 Act become operative on, and apply 32to conduct occurring on or after, January 1, 2010. 33 "(2) The Department of State Police may adopt rules or take any other action before the 34 operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the de-35partment to exercise, on or after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, 1 all the duties, functions and powers conferred on the department by this 2009 Act.

2 "<u>SECTION 8.</u> This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect
on its passage.".

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
