

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2463

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “and”.

2 In line 3, before the period insert “; and declaring an emergency”.

3 In line 12, after the second “who” delete the rest of the line and delete lines 13 and 14 and in-
4 sert “possesses a valid license that the Department of State Police has determined by rule is a re-
5 ciprocal license under section 6 of this 2009 Act.”.

6 On page 2, line 3, after the second “who” delete the rest of the line and delete lines 4 and 5 and
7 insert “possesses a valid license that the Department of State Police has determined by rule is a
8 reciprocal license under section 6 of this 2009 Act.”.

9 In line 20, after “license” delete the rest of the line and delete lines 21 and 22 and insert “that
10 the Department of State Police has determined by rule is a reciprocal license under section 6 of this
11 2009 Act.”.

12 In line 45, after the second “who” delete the rest of the line and insert “possesses a valid license
13 that the Department of State Police has determined by rule is a reciprocal license under section 6
14 of this 2009 Act.”.

15 On page 3, delete lines 1 and 2.

16 In line 41, after “and” delete the rest of the line and delete lines 42 and 43 and insert “possesses
17 a valid license that the Department of State Police has determined by rule is reciprocal license un-
18 der section 6 of this 2009 Act.”.

19 Delete line 45 and delete page 4 and insert:

20 **“SECTION 6. (1) As used in this section, ‘reciprocal license’ means a license or permit**
21 **issued in another state by a state or local law enforcement agency, a court or another issu-**
22 **ing authority that authorizes the licensee or permittee to carry a concealed handgun in the**
23 **state in which the license or permit was issued, if the other state:**

24 **“(a) Authorizes a person who is licensed under ORS 166.291 and 166.292 to carry a con-**
25 **cealed handgun in the other state; and**

26 **“(b) Imposes eligibility requirements for the issuance of the license or permit that are**
27 **substantially similar to the requirements of ORS 166.291 and 166.292.**

28 **“(2) The Department of State Police shall adopt rules that identify states that issue re-**
29 **ciprocal licenses.**

30 **“SECTION 7. (1) Section 6 of this 2009 Act and the amendments to ORS 166.173, 166.260,**
31 **166.262, 166.370 and 166.663 by sections 1 to 5 of this 2009 Act become operative on, and apply**
32 **to conduct occurring on or after, January 1, 2010.**

33 **“(2) The Department of State Police may adopt rules or take any other action before the**
34 **operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the de-**
35 **partment to exercise, on or after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section,**

1 all the duties, functions and powers conferred on the department by this 2009 Act.

2 SECTION 8. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
3 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect
4 on its passage.”

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
