SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Creates sentencing enhancement for sexual abuse in second degree when offender is 21 years of age or older and is minor victim's athletic coach.

Modifies crime of sexual abuse in second degree to include sexual contact when offender is 21 years of age or older and is minor victim's athletic coach.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to sexual abuse; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 163.425.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section, "coach" means a person who instructs or trains 5 an individual or members of a team in a sport.

6 (2) The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall classify sexual abuse in the second

7 degree as described in ORS 163.425 (1)(a) as a crime category 8 of the sentencing guidelines

8 grid of the commission if:

9 (a) The victim is incapable of consent by reason of being under 18 years of age;

10 (b) The offender is 21 years of age or older; and

(c) At any time before the commission of the offense, the offender was the victim's
coach.

13 **SECTION 2.** ORS 163.425 is amended to read:

14 163.425. (1) A person commits the crime of sexual abuse in the second degree when:

15 (a) [that] The person subjects another person to sexual intercourse, deviate sexual intercourse

16 or, except as provided in ORS 163.412, penetration of the vagina, anus or penis with any object other

17 than the penis or mouth of the actor and the victim does not consent thereto; or

18 (b)(A) The person violates ORS 163.415 (1)(b);

19 (B) The person is 21 years of age or older; and

20 (C) At any time before the commission of the offense, the person was the victim's coach 21 as defined in section 1 of this 2009 Act.

22 (2) Sexual abuse in the second degree is a Class C felony.

23 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Section 1 of this 2009 Act and the amendments to ORS 163.425 by section 2 24 of this 2009 Act apply to conduct occurring on or after the effective date of this 2009 Act.
