

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2477

April 29

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 3, delete the comma and insert “and” and delete “and
2 342.143”.

3 On page 2, line 3, after “(3)” insert “(a)”.

4 After line 3, insert:

5 “(b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a) of this subsection, invasion of personal privacy is a Class
6 A misdemeanor if the person who committed the offense is under 18 years of age and has not pre-
7 viously been convicted of, or found to be within the jurisdiction of the juvenile court for having
8 committed an act that if committed by an adult would constitute, invasion of personal privacy.”.

9 Delete lines 14 and 15 and insert:

10 “(a) The person who makes or records the visual recording is the father, mother, sibling,
11 grandparent, aunt, uncle or first cousin, by blood, adoption or marriage, of the person under 12 years
12 of age; and”.

13 On page 3, lines 5 through 9, delete the boldfaced material and restore the bracketed material.

14 In line 9, delete “or (t)” and insert “, (t) or (u)” and delete the second “or”.

15 After line 9, insert:

16 “(t) Invasion of personal privacy under ORS 163.700 (1)(b), if the offender was at least 18 years
17 of age at the time the offense was committed and the offender has a prior conviction for invasion
18 of personal privacy that was committed when the offender was at least 18 years of age; or”.

19 Delete lines 22 through 45 and delete page 4 and insert:

20 “**SECTION 4. The amendments to ORS 163.700 and 163.702 by sections 1 and 2 of this 2009**
21 **Act apply to offenses committed on or after the effective date of this 2009 Act.**”.
