Modifies crime of sexual abuse in second degree to include intentionally propelling dangerous substance at another person for purpose of arousing or gratifying sexual desire.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 163.425 is amended to read:
5	163.425. (1) A person commits the crime of sexual abuse in the second degree [when that] if the
6	person:
7	(a) Subjects another person to sexual intercourse, deviate sexual intercourse or, except as pro
8	vided in ORS 163.412, penetration of the vagina, anus or penis with any object other than the peni
9	or mouth of the actor and the victim does not consent thereto; or
10	(b) For the purpose of arousing or gratifying the sexual desire of the person or anothe
11	person, intentionally propels any dangerous substance at a victim who does not consen
12	thereto.
13	(2) Sexual abuse in the second degree is a Class C felony.
14	(3) As used in this section, "dangerous substance" means blood, urine, semen or feces.
15	SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 163.425 by section 1 of this 2009 Act apply to con
16	duct occurring on or after the effective date of this 2009 Act.
