

# House Bill 2478

Sponsored by Representatives BRUUN, BARKER; Representatives BARTON, GELSER, THOMPSON, WINGARD

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Modifies crime of sexual abuse in second degree to include intentionally propelling dangerous substance at another person.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to bodily fluids; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 163.425.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 163.425 is amended to read:

5 163.425. (1) A person commits the crime of sexual abuse in the second degree [*when that*] **if the**  
6 **person:**

7 (a) Subjects another person to sexual intercourse, deviate sexual intercourse or, except as pro-  
8 vided in ORS 163.412, penetration of the vagina, anus or penis with any object other than the penis  
9 or mouth of the actor and the victim does not consent thereto; **or**

10 (b) **Intentionally propels any dangerous substance at another person and the victim does**  
11 **not consent thereto.**

12 (2) Sexual abuse in the second degree is a Class C felony.

13 (3) **As used in this section, "dangerous substance" means blood, urine, semen or feces.**

14 **SECTION 2.** **The amendments to ORS 163.425 by section 1 of this 2009 Act apply to con-**  
15 **duct occurring on or after the effective date of this 2009 Act.**
