

House Bill 2482

Sponsored by Representative CLEM (at the request of Paul Evans)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires state agencies to add question on agency forms and publications regarding receipt of information about veterans' benefits.

Becomes operative January 1, 2012.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state agencies.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2009 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 183.**

5 **SECTION 2. Every state agency shall include in a form or publication sent out to the**
6 **public by the state agency a question whether the recipient is a veteran and whether the**
7 **recipient would like information sent to the recipient regarding veterans' benefits.**

8 **SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2009 Act becomes operative on January 1, 2012.**
