House Bill 2488

Sponsored by Representative CAMERON; Representatives BARKER, SHIELDS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires contracting agency to include in solicitation for public contract and in contract terms provision to encourage bidders, proposers and contractors to hire individuals released from Department of Corrections institution.

1 A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to hiring in connection with a public contract.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2009 Act is added to and made a part of the Public Contracting Code.
 - **SECTION 2.** (1) As used in this section:
- 7 (a) "Department of Corrections institution" has the meaning given that term in ORS 8 421.005.
 - (b) "Oregon resident" means an individual who established residency in this state before the individual's incarceration in a Department of Corrections institution by:
 - (A) Possessing an Oregon driver license;
 - (B) Registering to vote in this state;
 - (C) Owning or leasing property in this state; or
 - (D) Filing an Oregon state income tax return.
 - (2) A contracting agency shall include in a solicitation for a public contract and in the terms of the public contract a provision that encourages bidders, proposers and contractors to hire Oregon residents who have been released from a Department of Corrections institution. The solicitation for the public contract and the public contract terms shall also identify and describe applicable financial incentives or other advantages available to a bidder, proposer or contractor that hires an Oregon resident who has been released from a Department of Corrections institution.
 - SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2009 Act applies to contracts first advertised or otherwise solicited or, if not advertised or solicited, first entered into on or after the effective date of this 2009 Act.
