SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Directs State Department of Fish and Wildlife to conduct feasibility study regarding development of zone to improve fish habitat [*between Lower Bennett Dam and Gardner Ditch on North Santiam River*] **in specified areas. Directs department to report on study to Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly on or before February 1, 2011.**
Sunsets January 2, 2012.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to North Santiam River.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The State Department of Fish and Wildlife shall conduct a feasibility**
5 **study regarding the development of a zone to improve fish habitat:**

6 **(a) Between the Upper Bennett Dam and the confluence of Gardner Ditch with the main**
7 **stem of the North Santiam River; and**

8 **(b) Between the Lower Bennett Dam and the confluence of Gardner Ditch with the main**
9 **stem of the North Santiam River.**

10 **(2) In conducting the study, the department shall consult with other state agencies hav-**
11 **ing a common interest in fish habitat improvement, the Santiam Water Control District, the**
12 **City of Stayton and the City of Salem.**

13 **(3) The department shall report the results of the study to the Seventy-sixth Legislative**
14 **Assembly not later than February 1, 2011.**

15 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2009 Act is repealed on January 2, 2012.**
