House Bill 2508

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires state institutions of higher education to waive student fees for teachers and employees receiving tuition remission.

A BILL FOR AN ACT
Relating to higher education faculty.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. A state institution of higher education listed in ORS 352.002 shall waive the student fees of a teacher or employee of the institution if the teacher or employee:

(1) Is attending the institution for the purpose of receiving a graduate degree; and
(2) Is receiving tuition remission from the institution.
