7	sition for which application is made [within 15 years of] at any time after discharge or release from
8	service in the Armed Forces. [Such time limit shall not apply in the case of a disabled veteran.]
9	SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 408.235 by section 1 of this 2009 Act apply to ap
10	plications for positions submitted on or after the effective date of this 2009 Act.
