SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Requires [*business*] **owner or operator of facility in which electronic signaling device is located** to post contact number for emergency response personnel in event that electronic signaling device is activated outside of normal business hours.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to electronic signaling devices.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:**

5 (a) **"Electronic signaling device" includes, but is not limited to:**

6 (A) **Electronic signaling devices, as defined in ORS 401.605;**

7 (B) **Emergency locator transmitters;**

8 (C) **Emergency Position Indicator Radio Beacon devices; and**

9 (D) **Wilderness personal locator beacons.**

10 (b)(A) **"Facility" includes:**

11 (i) **Commercial and industrial facilities;**

12 (ii) **Aircraft hangars, whether used for private, commercial or industrial purposes; and**

13 (iii) **Other facilities in which electronic signaling devices or equipment containing elec-**
14 **tronic signaling devices are sold, rented, serviced or repaired.**

15 (B) **"Facility" does not include a dwelling used only as a private residence.**

16 (c) **"Public safety answering point" has the meaning given that term in ORS 401.710.**

17 (d) **"9-1-1 service area" has the meaning given that term in ORS 401.710.**

18 (2) **The owner or operator of a facility in which an electronic signaling device is located**
19 **shall conspicuously post an emergency contact telephone number of an individual who is able**
20 **to assist emergency response personnel with locating and silencing the device.**

21 (3) **Subsection (2) of this section does not apply to the owner or operator of a facility for**
22 **which the owner or operator has provided a contact number to the public safety answering**
23 **point that is responsible for the 9-1-1 service area in which the facility is located.**
