House Bill 2521

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires business to post contact number for emergency response personnel in event that electronic signaling device is activated outside of normal business hours.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to electronic signaling devices.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) A business in which an electronic signaling device is located shall con-

5 spicuously post an emergency contact telephone number of a person who is able to assist

6 emergency response personnel with locating and silencing the device. For the purpose of this

7 subsection, an electronic signaling device includes but is not limited to:

8 (a) Electronic signaling devices, as defined in ORS 401.605;

9 (b) Emergency locator transmitters; and

10 (c) Emergency Position Indicator Radio Beacon devices.

11 (2) Subsection (1) of this section does not apply to a business that provides a contact

12 number to the 9-1-1 center responsible for the jurisdiction in which the business is located.

- (3) The Office of Emergency Management shall adopt rules necessary for the adminis tration of this section.
- 15 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) The Office of Emergency Management may impose a civil penalty not to
 16 exceed \$500 against a person who violates section 1 of this 2009 Act.
- 17 (2) Civil penalties under this section shall be imposed as provided in ORS 183.745.
