## House Bill 2532

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Specifies that statutes and rules that apply to school district boards, school districts or public schools do not apply to small schools. Provides exceptions.

  - (3) Notwithstanding subsection (2) of this section, a school district board may specify that statutes and rules that apply to school district boards, school districts or other public schools apply to a small school within the school district.
  - SECTION 4. The amendments to section 1 of this 2009 Act by section 3 of this 2009 Act become operative on July 1, 2017.
  - SECTION 5. The amendments to section 1 of this 2009 Act by section 3 of this 2009 Act first apply to the 2017-2018 school year.

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
