SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Repeals statutory designation of person or organization engaging services of musician as employer of musician for purposes of unemployment insurance compensation taxes unless written contract between parties provides exception.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to unemployment insurance compensation taxes for musicians; creating new provisions; re-
3 pealing ORS 657.506; and declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. ORS 657.506 is repealed.**

6 **SECTION 2. The repeal of ORS 657.506 by section 1 of this 2009 Act applies to the per-**
7 **formance of services by a musician or musicians on or after the effective date of this 2009**
8 **Act.**

9 **SECTION 3. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect**
11 **on its passage.**
