

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2557

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “faculty” insert a period and delete the rest of the  
2 line.

3 Delete lines 7 through 11.

4 Delete lines 14 through 20.

5 In line 21, delete “tenured or tenure-track”.

6 On page 2, line 13, delete “tenure and tenure-track”.

7 In line 23, delete “American” and insert “Oregon”.

8 In line 24, delete “and” and insert “now, therefore,”.

9 Delete lines 25 through 27.

10 Delete lines 29 through 45 and delete pages 3 and 4 and insert:

11 **“SECTION 1. As used in sections 2 and 3 of this 2009 Act, ‘public institution of higher  
12 education’ means:**

13 **“(1) A community college; or**

14 **“(2) A state institution of higher education listed in ORS 352.002.**

15 **“SECTION 2. (1) A part-time faculty member at a public institution of higher education  
16 is eligible for the same health care benefits as full-time faculty members if the part-time  
17 faculty member is eligible for membership in the Public Employees Retirement System by  
18 teaching either at a single public institution of higher education or in aggregate at multiple  
19 public institutions of higher education during the prior year.**

20 **“(2) A part-time faculty member at a public institution of higher education shall pay all  
21 insurance premiums for health care benefits unless otherwise provided for by the policy of  
22 the institution or by collective bargaining at the institution.**

23 **“(3) The Oregon Educators Benefit Board and the Public Employees’ Benefit Board shall  
24 each adopt rules to implement subsections (1) and (2) of this section.**

25 **“SECTION 3. The State Board of Education and the State Board of Higher Education  
26 shall establish baselines and conduct annual reviews of each public institution of higher ed-  
27 ucation with respect to the employment of full-time faculty and of faculty working less than  
28 full-time. Each public institution of higher education shall provide the necessary data for the  
29 board’s report prior to September 1 of each year. The boards shall report the results of the  
30 reviews to the Legislative Assembly and the Governor’s office prior to October 1 of each  
31 year. The reviews shall include:**

32 **“(1) Examination of data related to the ratio of courses taught by the following faculty  
33 categories:**

34 **“(a) Full-time faculty;**

35 **“(b) Part-time faculty; and**

- 1       **“(c) Graduate assistants;**
- 2       **“(2) The pay differential for the faculty categories; and**
- 3       **“(3) The health care and other benefits provided for each faculty category.”.**
