

House Bill 2565

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION (at the request of Oregon Vehicle Dealer Association)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Transportation to establish procedures to expedite titling of vehicles.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to expedited titling of vehicles; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 803.207.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2009 Act is added to and made a part of the Oregon Vehicle Code.

SECTION 2. (1) The Department of Transportation by rule shall establish procedures for providing expedited services related to the titling of vehicles.

(2) The department shall charge a fee of at least \$20 but not more than \$100 for providing expedited services authorized by this section.

(3) The department shall provide a title to an applicant within three days after receiving an application and fee for expedited titling services.

SECTION 3. ORS 803.207 is amended to read:

803.207. (1) The Department of Transportation by rule may establish procedures for providing expedited services related to the [*titling and*] registration of vehicles when such services are needed because of problems related to odometer disclosure requirements. This authority is in addition to the department's authority to provide expedited **registration** services for other reasons on an individual case basis.

(2) The department may charge a fee of not more than \$10 for providing expedited services authorized by this section.
