17	Health for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, for the purpose of administering and enforc-
18	ing the duties, functions and powers transferred by section 1 of this 2009 Act.
19	"(3) The expenditure classifications, if any, established by Acts authorizing or limiting
20	expenditures by the Oregon Student Assistance Commission remain applicable to expen-
21	ditures by the Office of Rural Health under this section.".

26	"SECTION 13. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
27	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect
28	on its passage.".
