House Bill 2582

Sponsored by Representative ROBLAN

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Establishes Oregon Center for Business and Economic Education to increase student education in business and economics. Appropriates moneys from General Fund to center for purposes of center. Sunsets January 2, 2016. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2009.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to Oregon Center for Business and Economic Education; appropriating money; and declar-2 3 ing an emergency. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 4 SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Center for Business and Economic Education is established 5 6 in Florence, Oregon. 7 (2) The Governor shall appoint a director for the center. 8 (3) The purpose of the center is to increase student education in business and economics. 9 The center shall fulfill the purpose of the center by working with: 10 (a) School districts that offer education programs in kindergarten through grade 12; (b) Community colleges; and 11 12 (c) State institutions of higher education. 13 (4) To fulfill the purpose of the center, the center may: (a) Hire staff for the center; 14 (b) Adopt rules necessary for the operation of the center; and 15 (c) Perform other duties as necessary for the operation of the center. 16 (5) The director of the center shall report annually to the Department of Education and 17 the Department of Higher Education on the operations of the center. 18 19 (6)(a) The center may accept contributions of moneys or properties that are donated for 20 the use or benefit of the center and use the moneys or properties for the purposes for which 21 they were donated. 22(b) All moneys received by the center under paragraph (a) of this subsection shall be paid into the State Treasury and deposited in the General Fund to the credit of the center. 2324 SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Center for Business and Economic Education, for the biennium beginning 25July 1, 2009, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$900,000, which may be expended for 26 27 carrying out the purposes of the center. SECTION 3. Section 1 of this 2009 Act is repealed on January 2, 2016. 28 SECTION 4. (1) On January 2, 2016, the Oregon Center for Business and Economic Edu-29 cation is abolished. 30

(2) The director of the Oregon Center for Business and Economic Education shall wind
up the affairs of the center before January 2, 2016.
(3) On January 2, 2016, all unobligated and unexpended moneys available to the center
are transferred to the General Fund and are available for general governmental purposes.
<u>SECTION 5.</u> This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect
July 1, 2009.
