SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Education for purposes of developing, establishing and administering five Mandarin immersion programs. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2009.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to Mandarin immersion programs; appropriating money; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-

5 ated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out of the

6 General Fund, the amount of \$1,600,000 for the purposes of:

7 (1) Developing and establishing five Mandarin immersion programs by providing \$300,000

8 to each program. The programs shall be, to the extent practicable and as determined by the

9 Superintendent of Public Instruction, in each congressional district.

10 (2) Administering the development and establishment of the Mandarin immersion pro-

11 grams described in subsection (1) of this section by providing \$100,000 to the Department of

12 Education for administration purposes.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect
July 1, 2009.
