## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Increases maximum penalty for crime of interfering with a law enforcement animal to maximum

of 5 years' imprisonment, \$125,000 fine, or both.] [Increases maximum penalty for crime of assaulting a law enforcement animal to maximum of 10 years' imprisonment, \$250,000 fine, or both.] Imposes additional fine of \$500 on person convicted of crime of interfering with law

enforcement animal.

Imposes additional fine of \$1,000 on person convicted of crime of assaulting law enforcement animal.
