House Bill 2721

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Directs Oregon Department of Administrative Services to transfer certain amounts from Tobacco Settlement Funds Account to Department of Human Services for certain purposes. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to financial administration of the Tobacco Settlement Funds Account; and declaring an
emergency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> In addition to transfers to the Tobacco Enforcement Fund under ORS 6 293.537, the Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall make the following trans-

7 fers to the Department of Human Services from the Tobacco Settlement Funds Account for

8 the biennium beginning July 1, 2009:

9 (1) The amount of \$7 million for the purposes of tobacco prevention and education; and

10 (2) The amount of \$13 million for allocation to county health departments.

11 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 12 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect 13 on its passage.
