

House Bill 2721

Sponsored by Representative MAURER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Oregon Department of Administrative Services to transfer certain amounts from Tobacco Settlement Funds Account to Department of Human Services for certain purposes.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to financial administration of the Tobacco Settlement Funds Account; and declaring an
3 emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. In addition to transfers to the Tobacco Enforcement Fund under ORS**
6 **293.537, the Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall make the following trans-**
7 **fers to the Department of Human Services from the Tobacco Settlement Funds Account for**
8 **the biennium beginning July 1, 2009:**

9 (1) **The amount of \$7 million for the purposes of tobacco prevention and education; and**

10 (2) **The amount of \$13 million for allocation to county health departments.**

11 **SECTION 2. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
12 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect**
13 **on its passage.**
