## House Bill 2733

Sponsored by Representative SCHAUFLER

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## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Requires Department of Transportation to include asphaltic concrete pavement mix composed of up to five percent recycled asphaltic shingles in materials selected for construction, maintenance and operation of state highways.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2	Relating to asphaltic concrete pavement mix; amending ORS 366.305.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 366.305 is amended to read:
5	366.305. (1) The Department of Transportation may select the materials to be used in the con-
6	struction, maintenance and operation of state highways. It may purchase or contract for, independ
7	ent of any particular job, improvement or highway project, whether done by contract, force account
8	or otherwise, any material, supplies or equipment deemed necessary for carrying out the provision
9	and purposes of this Act in such amounts and manner and pursuant to such method as in the judg
10	ment of the department will be for the best interests of the state.
11	(2)(a) Materials selected under subsection (1) of this section must include asphaltic con
12	crete pavement mix composed of up to five percent recycled asphaltic shingles.
13	(b) The department shall establish by rule specifications related to the selection of

asphaltic concrete pavement mix under this section.
