

House Bill 2757

Sponsored by Representatives ESQUIVEL, KRIEGER; Representatives FREEMAN, THATCHER, WHISNANT

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Legislative Assembly to include appropriations exceeding \$5 million in separate bills. Exempts appropriations for state agency budgets and expenditure limitations.

Relating to appropriation bills.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "state agency" means every state officer, board, commission, department, institution, branch or agency of the state government, whose costs are paid wholly or in part from funds held in the State Treasury.

(2) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, the Legislative Assembly shall include an appropriation for the current expenses of the state in an amount exceeding \$5 million in a bill that contains no other appropriations.

(3) Subsection (2) of this section does not apply to:

(a) Appropriations made for the biennial budget of a state agency; or

(b) Expenditure limitations.

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
