## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Designates May 8 of each year as Military Family Appreciation Day. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

3	Whereas Oregonians have a long-standing tradition of serving in the Armed Forces of the United
4	States, with thousands of Oregonians giving their lives in defense of this country; and
5	Whereas the contributions of Oregon military personnel have been vital to maintaining the
6	freedoms and way of life that Americans cherish; and
7	Whereas it is vital to raise awareness of the sacrifices that our brave men and women in uni-
8	form have made in the past and continue to make in order to defend the United States Constitution
9	and to preserve the liberties that enrich this great nation; and
10	Whereas it is important to recognize and honor the sacrifices, support and dedication of the
11	families of the men and women who have served; and
12	Whereas Oregonians recognize the importance of maintaining a strong, well-equipped, well-
13	educated and well-trained military to safeguard freedoms and maintain peacekeeping missions
14	around the world; now, therefore,
15	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
16	SECTION 1. May 8 of each year shall be known as Military Family Appreciation Day.
17	SECTION 2. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
18	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect
19	on its passage.
