Requires all school buses with diesel engines to be [repowered or] retrofitted with certain engines and technology by 2017 or replaced by recently manufactured school buses by 2025.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2	Relating to diesel engines.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2009 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 468A.795 to
5	468A.803.
6	SECTION 2. All school buses with diesel engines operated in Oregon must be:
7	(1) Retrofitted with 2007 equivalent engines and 2007 fine particulate matter capture
8	technology by January 1, 2017; or
9	(2) Replaced with school buses manufactured on or after January 1, 2007, by January 1
10	2025. A school bus replaced under this subsection may not be used for transportation of any
11	type.
