Allows certain municipalities to irrevocably convert urban renewal plan from standard rate plan to reduced rate plan for consolidated billing tax rate purposes.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to urban renewal plans; and declaring an emergency.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2009 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 457.
5	SECTION 2. The governing body of a municipality that adopted an urban renewal plan
6	before December 5, 1996 (other than an existing urban renewal plan designated as an Option
7	Three plan under ORS 457.435 (2)(c)), that would otherwise be required to use a consolidated
8	billing tax rate as defined in ORS 457.010 (4)(b) may, by resolution or ordinance, irrevocably
9	elect to have amounts collected by dividing the taxes for the urban renewal plan pursuant
10	to ORS 457.440 be determined instead by using the consolidated billing tax rate as defined in
11	ORS 457.010 (4)(a). This election applies first to the assessment roll next following if the
12	assessor has received notice of the election from the urban renewal agency before January
13	1.
14	SECTION 3. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
15	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect
16	on its passage.
