House Bill 2841

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Provides that if measure repealing Ballot Measure 57 (2008) (House Bill 2842) does not become law, other measure referring provisions of Ballot Measure 57 (2008) with funding source for provisions (House Bill 2843) is repealed.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. If House Bill 2842 does not become law, sections 1 (amending ORS 316.037),
6	2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 (amending ORS 137.717), 9 (amending ORS 164.162), 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16
7	17, 18 and 19, chapter, Oregon Laws 2009 (Enrolled House Bill 2843), are repealed.
8	SECTION 2. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
9	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect
10	on its passage.
