

# House Bill 2868

Sponsored by Representative VANORMAN; Representatives BAILEY, CLEM, DEMBROW, GILLIAM, KAHL, KOTEK, ROBLAN, SCHAUFLE, STIEGLER

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires child care providers exempt from certification or registration who receive funds from Department of Human Services to attend orientation.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to child care facilities.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2009 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 657A.250 to**  
5 **ORS 657A.450.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) A child care provider not subject to certification or registration who re-**  
7 **ceives funds for child care services from the Department of Human Services or from a pro-**  
8 **gram or agency that receives funds from the department shall attend an orientation provided**  
9 **by the department or a resource and referral agency under ORS 657A.100 to ORS 657A.190**  
10 **within 90 days of providing the child care services.**

11 **(2) The orientation required by subsection (1) of this section must provide information**  
12 **regarding financial resources and reimbursements available through private or public**  
13 **sources and information to maximize the likelihood of provider payments and reimburse-**  
14 **ments for child care services.**

15 **(3) The department shall ensure that at least one orientation required by subsection (1)**  
16 **of this section is offered in each department service delivery area every quarter.**

17 **(4) A child care provider described in subsection (1) of this section who ceases to provide**  
18 **child care services for a period of one year or more must attend an orientation under this**  
19 **section within 90 days of resuming providing child care services.**

20 **(5) The orientation required by subsection (1) of this section must be provided at minimal**  
21 **or no cost to the child care provider.**

22 **(6) The orientation required by subsection (1) of this section must include, but need not**  
23 **be limited to, information about the following:**

24 **(a) Department of Human Services listings, vouchers and payments;**

25 **(b) Child care provider rights and responsibilities;**

26 **(c) Enhanced rate training options;**

27 **(d) Food program resources available through the United States Department of Agricul-**  
28 **ture; and**

29 **(e) Other resources available to child care providers.**

30 **SECTION 3. (1) Section 2 of this 2009 Act applies to persons providing child care services**  
31 **on or after the operative date of section 2 of this 2009 Act.**

**NOTE:** Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter *[italic and bracketed]* is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.

1           **(2) Persons providing child care services on the operative date of section 2 of this 2009**  
2 **Act shall attend the orientation required by section 2 of this 2009 Act no later than 90 days**  
3 **after the operative date of section 2 of this 2009 Act.**

4           **SECTION 4.** **Section 2 of this 2009 Act becomes operative on June 30, 2010.**

5           **SECTION 5.** **The Department of Human Services may take any action before the opera-**  
6 **tive date of section 2 of this 2009 Act necessary to enable the department to provide the**  
7 **orientations required by section 2 of this 2009 Act on and after the operative date of section**  
8 **2 of this 2009 Act.**

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
