

House Bill 2869

Sponsored by Representative BARKER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Workers' Compensation Management-Labor Advisory Committee to study availability of interpreter services for workers' compensation claims and report findings to Legislative Assembly.

2 Relating to interpreter services in workers' compensation claims.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Workers' Compensation Management-Labor Advisory Committee**
5 **appointed under ORS 656.790 shall study the availability of interpreter services for workers'**
6 **compensation claims.**

7 **(2) Upon completion of the study required by this section, the committee shall report the**
8 **findings of the study to the Legislative Assembly in the manner provided in ORS 192.245.**
