## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Requires counties to appoint service officers. Exempts certain counties.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to service officers; amending ORS 408.410.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 408.410 is amended to read:

408.410. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, the county governing body  $\mathbf{5}$ in each county [may] shall appoint a service officer who shall give aid and assistance to any vet-6 eran, the spouse or dependents of the veteran or the survivors of the veteran, in applying for all 7 benefits and aid to which they are entitled by federal, state or local laws, rules and regulations. The 8 county governing body shall fix the compensation of the service officer, provide the service officer 9 with an office and the necessary equipment therefor in the same manner as provided for any other 10 county officer. [If a county governing body appoints a service officer,] The county governing body 11 12 shall also provide in the annual budget for expenditure of moneys sufficient to enable the county to employ the service officer, to properly maintain the office provided for the service officer and to pay 1314 the costs incurred by the service officer in providing assistance to veterans, spouses and dependents of veterans or survivors of veterans. The annual expenditures required by this section shall be made 15 16 from the county funds referred to in ORS 408.720.

(2) Gilliam, Sherman and Wheeler Counties are not required to appoint a service officer
under this section if a county that adjoins Gilliam, Sherman or Wheeler County has appointed a service officer.

20 [(2)] (3) As used in this section, "survivor of a veteran" means the spouse or a dependent of a 21 deceased veteran.
