

House Bill 2929

Sponsored by Representatives ROBLAN, KRIEGER; Representative BOONE

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of State Lands to employ at least one full-time equivalent employee to coordinate department's activities related to removal of commercial sand and gravel.

Allows department to apply for and receive certain private or federal grants, loans or other funds.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to Department of State Lands.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Department of State Lands shall employ at least one full-time equivalent**
5 **employee to coordinate the department's activities related to the removal of commercial**
6 **sand and gravel throughout the state.**

7 **SECTION 2. The Department of State Lands may apply for and receive any private or**
8 **federal grants, loans or other funds available for the purposes of conducting studies related**
9 **to the work of the department and coordinating state and federal permitting issues related**
10 **to removal and fill.**
