## House Bill 2956

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON BUSINESS AND LABOR

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires requests for proposals or invitations to bid issued for construction, reconstruction, purchase, rent, lease or acquisition of interstate bridge to contain certain provisions.

14	(B) Whether in fabricating the products, materials and components a proposer or bidder

16	(C) Whether the sites at which the products, materials or components are fabricated are
17	in close proximity to the bridge location; and
18	(D) Whether transportation costs and other conveniences favor or disfavor using pro-
19	ducts, materials and components manufactured in this state or the State of Washington.
20	(2) [Any] An agreement made or contract entered into pursuant to the authority of ORS 381.005
