## House Bill 2963

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Prohibits assistant attorneys general and deputy district attorneys from striking.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to strikes by certain public attorneys; amending ORS 243.736. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. ORS 243.736 is amended to read: 4 243.736. (1) It is unlawful for any of the following public employees to strike or recognize a 5 6 picket line of a labor organization while in the performance of official duties: 7 (a) Assistant attorneys general; 8 (b) Deputy district attorneys; 9 [(a)] (c) Emergency telephone worker; [(b)] (d) Employee of the Oregon Youth Authority who has custody, control or supervision of 10 youth offenders; 11 12 [(c)] (e) Firefighter; [(d)] (f) Guard at a correctional institution or mental hospital; 13 [(e)] (g) Parole and probation officer who supervises adult offenders; and 14 [(f)] (h) Police officer. 15 (2) As used in this section, "emergency telephone worker" means a person whose official focal 16 duties are receiving information through a 9-1-1 emergency reporting system under ORS 401.710 to 17 401.816, relaying the information to public or private safety agencies or dispatching emergency 18 equipment or personnel in response to the information. 19
