

House Bill 3005

Sponsored by Representative CLEM

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys to State Department of Agriculture for 2009-2011 biennium to develop business plan for project to produce energy from agricultural sources and from food or other wastes. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2009.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to business plans for energy production projects; appropriating money; and declaring an
3 emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
6 **ated to the State Department of Agriculture, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out**
7 **of the General Fund, the amount of \$100,000, which may be expended for the purpose of de-**
8 **veloping the business plan for a project to produce energy from agricultural sources, or from**
9 **food or other wastes, by anaerobic digestion, cellulosic ethanol production or other pro-**
10 **cesses.**

11 **SECTION 2. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
12 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect**
13 **July 1, 2009.**
